

How to run Bash Scripts on Windows using Git Bash

Git is a software that can help you run Bash Scripts on Windows.


You can download git for windows from the following link

After successful installation go to the folder where your bash script is present

right click on the windows file explorer and select [Open Git Bash Here](#)
