

What is a Password Vault ?

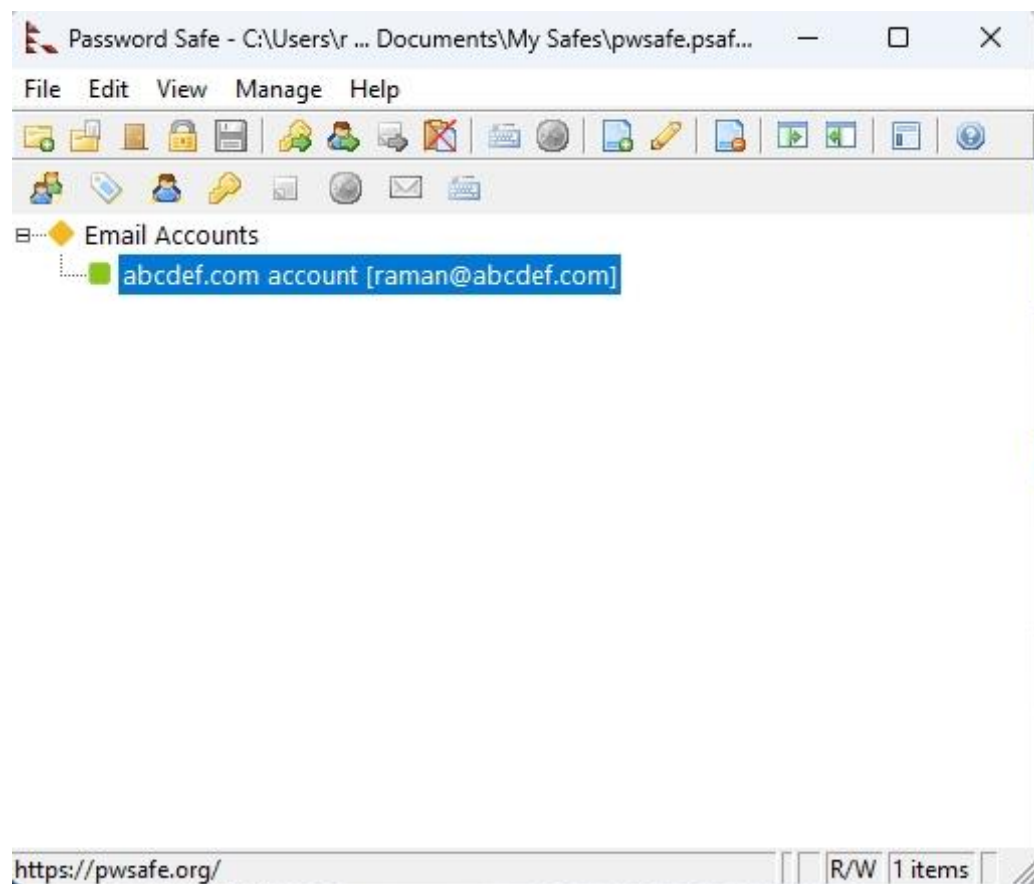
Password Vault is place where you store all your passwords. Password Vault can be Local or Server Based.

Local Password Vault means you are storing all your passwords in a file locally on your computer and keeping a single password on that file.

Server Based Password Vault means you are storing all your passwords on a server and keeping a password on it.

Example of a Local Password Vault is Password Safe and Server Based Password Vault is CyberArk which is a software developed by CyberArk Corporation.

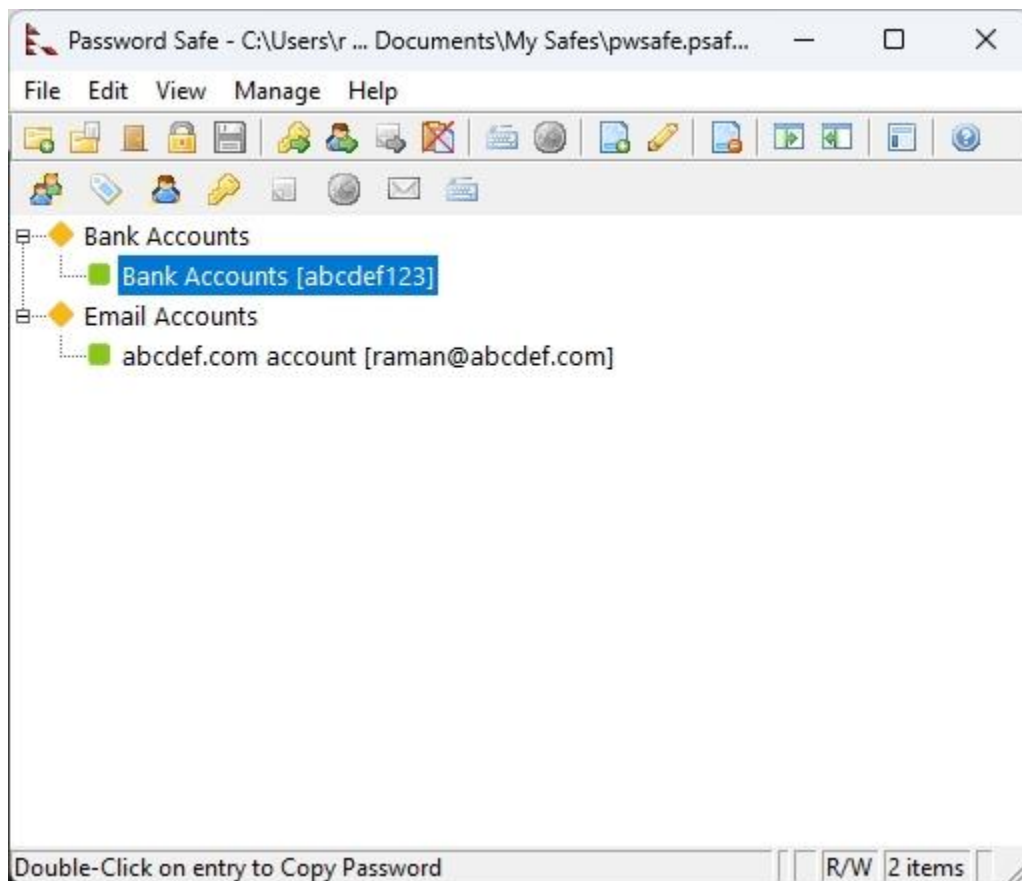
