

Keep Your Passwords in a single password protected word file or odt file and keep it updated on Internet using Mega Sync

Using the following technique you can store all your passwords in a single Microsoft Word File and keep a password on that file.

You can use a software Mega Sync to keep your password protected word file on Internet whenever you change a password in this word file.

Mega Sync gives you about 20 GB of free Storage space on a Data Centre.

You can also use Apache Open Office Document for password protecting your file if don't have Microsoft Word.

Apache Open Office can be downloaded from www.openoffice.org

Mega Sync can be downloaded from www.mega.io

Mega Sync automatically synchronizes your documents on Data Centre.

Synchronization means whenever you update or Delete a file in a folder that is synchronized in Mega Sync, it will be updated on the Data Centre.

How to Password Protect a Microsoft Word File

Go to File -> Info -> Protect Document and Click on Encrypt with Password.

Enter Password twice and Word Document File will be Protected with a Password.

Similarly you can also keep password on Apache Open Office Document File if you don't have Microsoft Word on Your Computer.
